GENERAL CIT PROGRAM INFORMATION FOR BOTH CAMPS

During your session as a CIT, you will experience assignments in different phases of the camp operation and be asked to complete certain training. You and your parents should recognize this is an opportunity to be associated with Scout leaders and camp administrators who are particularly skilled, well educated, and mature individuals with special backgrounds. You will also be associated with other young people of high standards and character who have been screened and selected for this program. Preference in selecting camp staff in future years will be given to successful graduates of the CIT program

As you consider this opportunity, you and your parents should be fully aware that during the weeks you spend as a CIT, your pay would only be the training you receive. In addition, you will receive both room and board and health and accident insurance, free of charge. The CIT must provide his own uniforms and spending money. At CSAC the Camp Director who provides supervision, training, program area placement and guidance directly supervises the CIT's. At Massawepie, a CIT Scoutmaster provides the same. If for some reason, after being accepted into the program, you fail to live up to the standards set for a CIT, you may be asked to leave the program by the Camp Director.
